HEAD COACH, ERIN COPPERNOLL

Erin Coppernoll has the most coaching victories in the history of the UW-Oshkosh women's soccer program and the third highest win total in Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference archives. Coppernoll has led the Titans to all five of their NCAA Division III postseason appearances, each of their five WIAC championships (two regular season, three postseason) and their lone WIAC Coaching Staff of the Year award.

Coppernoll has lead the Titans for 21 seasons. Her UW-Oshkosh resume also includes NCAA postseason visits in 2006, 2011, 2014, 2015 and 2021 in addition to WIAC regular season championships in 2015 and 2021, and league tournament crowns in 2011, 2014 and 2021.

Coach Coppernoll has coached club, high school and college soccer for 24 years. In 2021, Coppernoll won Wisconsin's Girls Competitive Coach of the Year, Midwest Girls Competitive Coach of the Year, and the National Girls Coach of the Year within US Soccer. She holds an Advanced National Diploma from USC and a "C" License from the United States Soccer Federation (USSF).

ASSISTANT COACH, GREG RUARK

Greg Ruark joined the Titans as the top women's soccer assistant coach in 2024. He began his coaching career as an assistant coach at DePauw University (Ind.). In his first stint as a head coach, Ruark was the men's soccer coach at Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology from 1988 to 2002. He served as the Fightin' Engineers' first women's coach during the initial 1999 campaign as well as in 2000. The Fightin' Engineers earned Academic All-America honors in 1989 and 1990 under Ruark.

His last collegiate coaching stop was as the head coach of the Ripon College Redhawks women's soccer program for five seasons from 2017 to 2021 after being assistant for a year. Five Redhawks earned All-Midwest Conference honors during his tenure, and one student-athlete was named the MWC's Elite 20 award winner.

Before his stint at Ripon, Ruark was with the Oshkosh United Soccer Club as the director of player development and Lawrence University as an assistant men's soccer coach. From 2013 to 2018, he was the head girl's soccer coach at Oshkosh West High School.

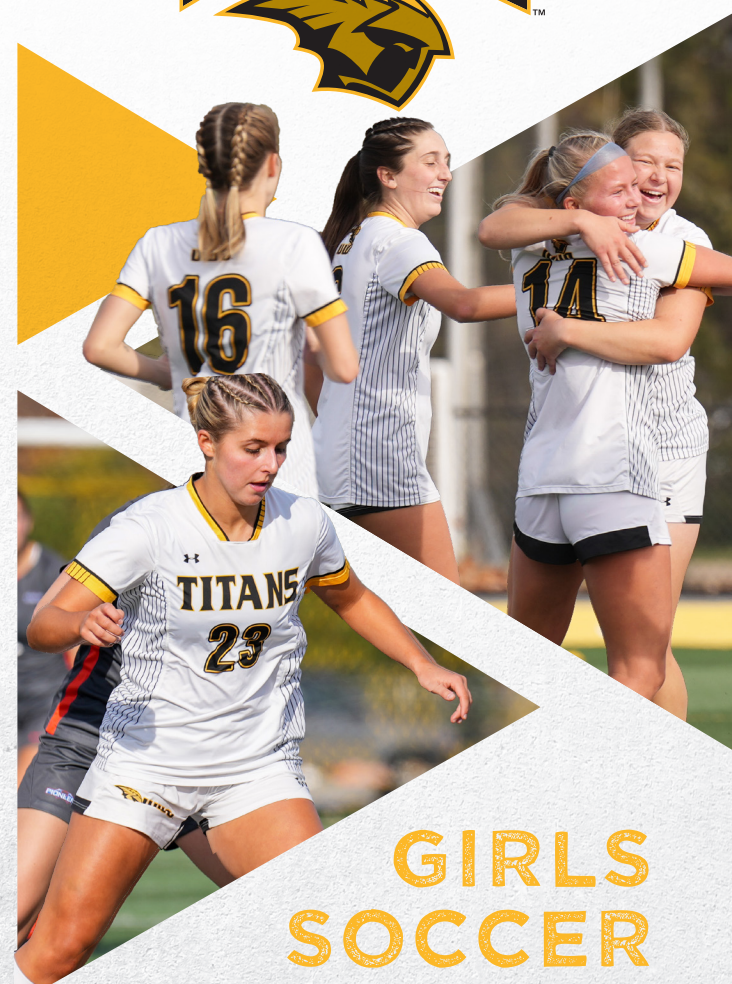
